

## WORKSHEET: Who uses this?

### Curriculum links

PSHE, English

### Skills development (3 high to 1 low)



### Learning Aims

To get the children to find out what you do for your job and find out what your business does in a fun and accessible way.

Explore the skills you need to be successful in your job.

### Resources Required

- An item that you use and is essential to help you do your job.
- Paper and pens

### Lesson plan

In a relatively simple workshop lesson, pupils are shown an item / a tool / a building / a vehicle and asked to think about the types of people / jobs that would commonly use them.

Show the children an object or photo of something that you use to do your job. Get the children to guess:

1. What the item is?
2. Who would use that item in their job?

After, introduce yourself to the children and explain what you do and how you use the item to help you to do your job, what skills (linking back to the 7 skills above) you need to be successful in your job.

You could show a video of how the item is used in your workplace or demonstrate how the item is used.
